Deer hunting season is here. When hunting deer and other large game, you may hunt with a rifle or shotgun. Fully automatic and semiautomatic rifles are prohibited. Hunters in Pennsylvania are allowed the use of manually operated handguns such as revolvers or single shot centerfire handguns, for hunting purposes. Do not under any circumstances use your personal protection semi-automatic handgun to fire at the deer if you're hunting. You cannot hunt from a vehicle.

When you're traveling to your hunting site, your hunting long guns must be completely unloaded when they are in the vehicle, even if you have a License to Carry. Be Safe, Be Educated.

HANDGUN SAFETY CLASSES

The course covers SAFETY, function, care and cleaning, sight alignment, trigger control, grip and other information on how to shoot a handgun safely and accurately. This course is offered over weekend sessions. Classes will meet and be held in the Clubhouse at Harrisburg Hunters and Anglers. The range session will be conducted in the indoor range on the second day of the course. All instructors are NRA Certified. YOU MUST ATTEND BOTH DAYS TO COMPLETE THE COURSE.

SATURDAY AND SUNDAY MORNING. The course is \$65.00 (payable at the first class via cash or check only). The course is open to the public. NO NEED TO OWN A HANDGUN. INDOOR NOVELTY SHOOTS

We will be holding our 2020 winter Novelty Shoots at the indoor pistol range on the following 2nd Sundays, from 1:00 pm to 3:30 pm, using handguns:

- January 12 .22 Rim Fire February 9 .22 Rim Fire
- March 8 Center Fire, using .380, 9mm, or .38 caliber

As usual, we will be shooting paper Luck Targets (e.g., poker cards, random numbers, bowling pins, coins, pool balls, dart boards, bullseyes, etc.) at 50 feet. Revolvers and semi-autos may be used. Red dots are allowed. No holster required. Two-hand hold is ok. Usually 5 shots per target per relay, and about 8 relays.

Cost is \$2 per relay, with a 50% payback to the shooters using the Lewis Classification System. Shoot as many relays as you like. First-time shooters are WELCOME and our matches are open to the public. Come on out and join us for some fun, and bring a shooting friend with you.

INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN SKILLS COURSE

This course is a prerequisite for more advanced classes, such as HHA Defensive Handgun Skills Class. Students will review basic fundamentals and experience more intense hands on handgun training. This class will be limited in size and students must have previously completed the Basic Handgun Safety class WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS. Students are required to have a center fire handgun (.22LR rim fire handguns are not acceptable). Semi-automatics must be a .380/9mm caliber or larger, and revolvers must be a double action only .38 caliber or larger. Students must also have two magazines or speed loaders, their own eye and ear protection, and provide their own ammunition (200 rounds). All of the instructors are NRA-Certified. The course is \$50.00; we accept cash or check only, no credit cards.

Scoring goes by a modified Boone & Crockett system. We will measure the inside spread, the length of beams and tines, and the circumferences, but there will not be deductions for a non-symmetric set of antlers. There are categories for Archery (including crossbow), Rifle, Handgun and Black Powder in Junior (under 16), Adult, and Senior (62 and over). Winners in each category will win a prize.

RANGE RULES

When using your club's ranges, it is your responsibility to know and understand the club's general ground rules and range regulations. They are published in the club by-laws. Copies of the by-laws are in the magazine rack just inside the front door of the clubhouse. Ground rules and range regulations are posted at each range. You are responsible for your actions on the ranges, so take the time to learn the club rules and be sure to follow them.

If you have any questions on club rules, or feel you need one-on-one training, please contact an officer of the club, or one of the board of directors, who will help you out.

Remember - safety is your responsibility. Make it your top priority.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL FORM, DUE BEFORE JANUARY 1

- This form can <u>only</u> be used if you are <u>renewing a membership</u>. If you were a member in the past 2 years, you may use this form; otherwise, you must use a New Member Application form to obtain membership.
- If changing from an Adult to Family membership, please use a New Member Application form and follow the instructions.
- If a previous year's junior member is 16 as of January 1, they must renew as a separate member. This includes children that are part of a family membership.
- If you do not renew your membership by December 31, your privileges to use any club facilities will be suspended (card keys will be disabled) until your renewal is received and processed. Allow at least two weeks to receive your membership card after we receive your renewal.
- ADULT: 22-61 years, JUNIOR: up to 15 years, YOUNG ADULT: 16-21 years, SENIOR: 62 years and older (ages as of Jan. 1).
- Make checks payable to HH&A. Applicant will be responsible for all bank fees for a check returned for any reason.
